WHAT DOES ENRICHMENT FEDERAL CREDIT UNION DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we can do.
What?	The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Social Security number and Account Balances • Payment History and Transaction History • Credit History and Account Transactions
How?	All financial companies need to share members' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their members' personal information; the reasons we choose to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

What we do	
How does Enrichment FCU protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.
How does Enrichment FCU collect my personal information?	We collect your personal information, for example, when you: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Open an account or provide employment information • Apply for a loan • Make deposits or withdrawals from your account We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.
Why can't I limit all sharing?	Federal law gives you the right to limit only <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes-information about your creditworthiness • Affiliates from using your information to market to you • Sharing for non affiliates to market to you State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.
What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?	Your choice will apply to everyone on your account.

Definitions	
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. Our affiliates are: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Enrichment Insurance Services
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Nonaffiliates we can share with can include insurance companies.</i>
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. These include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Our joint marketing partners include insurance companies.</i>
